1st November has been set aside as International Day of Prayer for Climate Justice. As Christians we believe that God made the world and entrusted us to care for it. Climate change shows that human beings are failing in the task of caring for God's creation. We live in what Pope Frances has called a "throwaway culture". The great injustice of climate change is that it is those who do least to cause it are suffering the most. We pollute but others pay the price. Ireland ranks among the highest greenhouse gas producers in the world. The energy used by each Irish person produces 100 times more carbon emissions than an African does. This is excessive and unjust.
